Junior competitors may not compete in adult kumite competition. Adult divisions are 17 years and older.

Note: Kumite - Juniors 15 yrs & under - body armour & head protectors are compulsory and supplied by ASKA.
Please supply your own hand mitts, leg pads, mouth guards, groin guards (boys) & chest protectors (girls).

DEFINITIONS:

- A) "Personal injury" has its ordinary English meaning and includes any injury for which a person might be awarded General damages and/or Special damages at Common Law;

- D) "Any action" means any claim right and/or cause of action for damages at Common Law or pursuant to any statute, and
- E) "The Rules" means the rules for time being of the Australian Karate Federation Incorporated.

- 2) I hereby acknowledge that my entry and/or participation in the tournament carries with it significant risk of personal injury.
